(New Zealand) Fresh nettle, gooseberry & tropical-fruit flavours abound and linger on the long, clean acid finish.

Barefoot Chardonnay (California) Tempting flavors of green apples & peaches with rich, buttery finish.

Barefoot Pinot Grigio (California) A supple entry leads to a dry-yet-fruity medium body of dried apricot, apple peel and delicate spice.

Barefoot White Zinfandel (California) Refreshing with tropical aromas; flavors of ripe strawberries and pears intensify the crisp finish.

Barefoot Moscato (California) Delightfully sweet with lush fruity aromas. Hints of citrus skip across flavors of juicy peach and ripe apricots.

Walnut Crest Merlot \$18⁵⁰

(Chile) A rugged style that features firm tannins, full body and rather raw fruit and herb flavors.

Louis Martini Cabernet Sauvignon \$19⁷⁵

(California) Ripe flavors of black plum jam & black currant hints of oak and a touch of baking spice support the fruit.
